3. The onions may be Autumn or Spring sown. The variety to be correctly named. Each onion must be tied and weigh not more than 450 grams.
4. The onions to be harvested and have clear unbroken skins.
5. A special qualifying class will be held at selected shows. Two exhibits may qualify for the Final, if the Judges agree that the standard is high enough.

**The competition will be judged as follows:**

- Conditions/Quality: 25 points,
- Uniformity and Shape: 25 points
- Size/Weight: 10 points,
- Colour: 10 points
- Overall presentation/attractiveness: 10 points.
