Rules and Conditions

1. The Bantam final is open to all breeds of True & Rare True Bantam Breeding Pairs i.e. Belgian, Dutch, Japanese, Pekin, Rosecomb, Sebright, Booted, Nankin & Ohiki.
2. No more than two pairs from each qualifying show will be eligible to compete in the final.
3. Individual competitors may qualify no more than one pair for the final.
4. Chickens qualifying for entry in the final may not be entered in any other classes at Swinford Show.
5. The chickens must be penned in the cages provided at the showgrounds by 10:30am.
6. Winners to be announced at 2pm.
7. These rules should be read in conjunction with the Irish Shows Association Rules and Swinford Agricultural Show Rules.
8. No bedding allowed in show cages.
9. Exhibitors must be owners and be present for the final.

Rules and Conditions

1. The Soft Feather final is open to all Soft Feather: Heavy Breeding Pairs i.e. Australorp, Barnevelder, Brahma, Cochin, Croad Langshran, Dorking, Faverolles, Frizzle, Marans, New Hampshire Red, Orpington, Plymouth Rock, Rhode Island Red, Sussex, Wyandotte.
2. No more than two pairs from each qualifying show will be eligible to compete in the final.
3. Individual competitors may qualify no more than one pair for the final.
4. Chickens qualifying for entry in the final may not be entered in any other classes at Swinford Show.
5. The chickens must be penned in the cages provided at the showgrounds by 10:30am.
6. Winners to be announced at 2pm.

Reserve Champion Bird of the Show will receive a Rosette plus €20 prize money**

Birds may be penned on morning of /show between 10-12 noon. All poultry must be visibly free from pests & disease, otherwise they will be disqualified.

No entries to be removed from pens before 4pm and with permission of committee. Presentation of cups and prizes at 3.45pm. All cups are Perpetual and remain property of North Sligo Agricultural Show. The welfare of all exhibits is the responsibility of the owner. Bring & Buy Poultry sale permitted. All birds for sale must be disease free & over six weeks old. No straw or dust allowed.
